This Indenture made this month day of August in
the year one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between
Martha Tyler of the town of Suffolk county of Massachusetts and
state of Virginia of the one part and Edward Reddick of the
same county and state of the other part Witnesseth that
the said Martha Tyler in consideration of three hundred
and sixteen dollars and fifty cents to her in hand paid by the
said Edward Reddick at or before the enacting and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain
and sell unto the said Edward Reddick his heirs and assigns
a tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and five
and a half acres be the same more or less it being her half
of the dower land laid of to her mother lying in the county
of Southampton and state aforesaid adjoining the other land
of the said Martha Tyler and the land of Edward Reddick
being part of the tract of land formerly belonged to Jeremiah
Tyler deceased together with all the houses woods ways
waters and water courses hereditaments and appurtenances
whatsoever to the said land belonging or appertaining to
the same and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders
yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of every part
and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said one hundred
and five and a half acres land with the herements heredita-
ments, and all and singular other the premises herein before
mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every
part and parcel thereof with every of their rights mem-
bers and appurtenances unto the said Edward Reddick his
heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and
behalf of him the said Edward Reddick his heirs and
assigns forever ~~and the said Martha~~
Tyler for herself and her heirs the said tract of land
