This Indenture made this thirteenth day of August
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen
between John Adams and Mary his wife of the county of South
ampton of the one part and Thomas Applwhite of the
aforesaid county of Southampton of the other part. Witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
and fifty dollars to the said John Adams and Mary his
wife in hand paid by the aforesaid Thomas Applwhite the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I the said John Adams
and Mary his wife hath granted bargained and sold and by
these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas
Applwhite and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of
Southampton and bounded by the lands of Zebulon Lewis
