This Indenture of three parts made the 8th day of May
in the year 1813 between Cordace Brantley of the county of
Southampton and Commonwealth of Virginia of the first part
and Ethelred Hart of the county of Northampton and
state of North Carolina of the second part and Miller
Frances of the county of Southampton and Commonwealth
of Virginia aforesaid of the third part Witnesseth that
whereas the said Cordace Brantley is justly indebted to the
said Ethelred Hart in the sum of One hundred dollars due
by bond bearing date the 26th day of August in the year
1812 and the interest on the same and that the said Ethelred
Hart is security for the said Cordace Brantley to Arthur
Hart of Northampton aforesaid for the sum of two hundred
dollars due by bond bearing date the 13th day of March
in the year 1813 and the interest thereon and that the said
Cordace Brantley is willing and desirous of securing the payment
of the said One hundred dollars and the interest to the said
Ethelred Hart and indemnifying and securing him the said
Ethelred Hart harmless for being his security to the said
Arthur Hart for the said sum of two hundred dollars and
the interest and in order to secure and indemnify and save the
said Ethelred Hart harmless in the above mentioned cases
the said Cordace Brantley on his part for and in consideration
of the premises and moreover for and in consideration of the
sum of One Dollar to him in hand paid the receipt whereof
