Brantley doth for himself his heirs executors and administrators
warrant and defend the right and title of the said Willie
Frances to the said Willie Frances his heirs executors administrators
and assigns for the within mentioned purposes and upon
special trust and confidence that if the said Cordell Brantley
shall on or before the 25th day of December next pay to the
said Ethelred Hart the above mentioned sum of One hundred
dollars and all interest therein and also pay in the same
time to the said Arthur Hart the above mentioned debt
of two hundred dollars and the interest thereon then all right
and title of the said negro Hark herein conveyed to the said
Willie Frances to cease and this deed to be absolutely void and
of no effect but if the said Cordell Brantley shall fail to
pay the two above mentioned debts or any part of them on
or before the said 25th day of December next then it shall
be the duty of the said Willie Frances after having received
a note in writing from the said Ethelred Hart requesting
him to do so to advertise as soon as it is convenient and at
the said slave Hark at public sale for ready money
giving ten days previous notice of the time and place of
sale by advertising the same at the house of the said Cordell
Brantley and two other public places in the said county
and the money arising from the said sale to pay in the first
place the said debt of One hundred dollars and the interest
thereon to the said Ethelred Hart and the said debt of two
hundred dollars and the interest thereon to the said Arthur
Hart and the costs of this adventure and expenses of the sale
and then to pay the surplus if any to the said Cordell Brantley
