James Lee
14th Sept 1819

This Indenture made this 25th day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Benjamin Johnston of the county of Southampton of the one part and James Lee of the same county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Johnston hath for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand five hundred Dollars hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said James Lee and to his heirs and assigns forever all his entire Interest claim and demand of in and to the tract or tracts of land on which the said James Lee now resides which interest the said Benjamin Johnston held from his late wife and which ^{she} held from her brother John Norfleeth and Sally Jones — To have and to hold the said entire Interest claim and demand of in and to the said tracts of land and premises and every part thereof unto him the said James Lee his heirs and assigns forever — against the claim and demand of him the said Benjamin Johnston his heirs executors or administrators and against the claim and demand of all and every other person whatsoever that may hereafter claim under the said Benjamin Johnston In Witness whereof the said Benjamin Johnston hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this 25th day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirteen —
