The Commonwealth of Virginia to Samuel Baykin
 and Samuel B. Boykin gentlemen justices of the peace for the
 county of Southampton greeting whereas Moses Hart and
 Sarah his wife by their certain Indenture of bargain and
 sale bearing date the 20th day of November 1813 have conveyed
 unto John Harris of the county of Southampton the fee simple
 whole of and in a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and
 being in the county of Southampton containing by estimation forty
 four acres of land be the same more or less and whereas the said
 Sarah Hart cannot conveniently travel to the court of our said
 County to acknowledge the same therefore we do give to you power
 to receive the acknowledgment which the said Sarah Hart shall
 be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained
 in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed and we do therefore
 command you that you do personally go the said Sarah Hart
 and receive her acknowledgment of the same and examine her
 privately and apart from the said Moses Hart her husband
 whether she doth the same freely and voluntarily without his
 persuasion or threats and whether she be willing that the same
 shall be recorded in our county court of Southampton
 and when you have received her acknowledgment and examined
 her as aforesaid that you distinctly and openly certify as thereof
 in our said county court under your seals sending her
 there this writ with the said Indenture hereto annexed
 Samuel Kello clerk of our said court at his office the
 10th day of November 1813 and 38th year of the Commonwealth
