 of him the said John Denegre his heirs and assigns forever
 and the said Spencer Perce and Emily his wife covenants and
 agrees to and with the said John Denegre for themselves their
 heirs executors and administrators that they will defend the
 title to the said land to the said John Denegre his
 heirs and assigns from all persons legally claiming the same
