This Indenture made this 16th day of January in the
year of our lord Christ One thousand eight hundred and fourteen
between John Turner of the county of Southampton and parish
of Stottoway of the one part and Willis Turner of the same
county and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said
John Turner for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar
good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by
the said Willis Turner the receipt whereof the said John Turner
doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and paid
hath bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these
present doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Willis
Turner to him and to his heirs forever one certain tract or
parcel of land and premises being one half of the plantation
whereon the said Turner now lives situate lying and being
in the county and parish aforesaid containing one hundred and
forty acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows
