This Indenture made this 11th day of December

In the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and Thirteen
between Leonard Cobb and Patsy his wife of Southampton
County and state of Virginia of the one part Matthew
Williams & James Morrell both of the County of Stafford
and state of North Carolina of the other part Witnesses

that they the said Leonard Cobb and Patsy his wife for and
in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars to them in
hand paid by them the said Matthew Williams and James
Morrell on or before the making and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and
themselves to be therewith fully satisfied contented and paid
have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
do grant bargain and sell unto them the said Matthew
Williams and James Morrell one certain tract or parcel
of land lying and being in the county of Southampton
on east side of Been Creek (that is to say) half an acre on the
South side of the said Creek and five acres adjoining on the
North side of said Creek be the same more or less and bounded
by the lands of them the said Matthew Williams James
Morrell and William Owens, To have and to hold the said
bargained premises forever and they the said Leonard Cobb
and Patsy his wife well for themselves their heirs executors
and administrators warrant and forever defend the lawful
claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever together
with all the appurtenances profits and emoluments to the
same in any manner belonging. In Witness whereof they
the said Leonard Cobb and Patsy his wife have hereunto
set their hands and affixed their seals this day and date
first above Written.
