This Indenture made this sixteenth day of Decr
 in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thir-
 teen between Richard B Kello and John C Gray Commis-
 -oners appointed by a decree of the county court of Hampton
 to sell the land of which James Stephenson de^d deid seized
 and possessed off in the county of Southampton of the one
 part and Benjamin Travis of the other part Witnesses
 that the said Richard B Kello and John C Gray in consid-
 -eration of the sum of two hundred and ninety dollars
 lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the
 said Benjamin Travis at or before the executing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
