said Brittain Harris and Martha his wife for and in
consideration of the sum of four hundred and thirty dollars
to them in hand paid by the said Owen Ricks at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
they the said Brittain Harris and Martha his wife do hereby
acknowledge and forever acquit and discharge the said
Owen Ricks of the same have bargained and sold aliened
conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do bargain
sell aliened convey and confirm unto the said Owen
