county and state of the second part Witnesseth that the said
Spencer Pierce and Emily his wife for and in consideration of the
sum of one hundred and fifty dollars current money of the United
States to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Camp at and
before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged and from every part of which
the said Thomas Camp and all his legal representatives are
freed exonerated and discharged have granted bargained, sold
aliened transferred enfeoffed and confirmed and do hereby grant
bargain sell alien transfer enfeoff and confirm unto the said
Thomas Camp his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being in the said county of Southampton
containing by survey twenty five acres and bounded as fol-
lows to wit beginning at Browns road running thence N
42 E 22 pole to a pine corner in Griffin's line thence
S 34 E 12 3/4 pole to a corner pine newly made in Griffin's
line thence S 79 W 56 pole by a dead oak to Browns
road aforesaid thence the various courses of the said road to the
beginning To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of
land
