

This Indenture made the 19th day of August in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Rice B
Pence and Frances his wife of the one part and Lawrence Cook of the
other part witnesseth that the said Rice B Pence for and in considera-
tion of the sum of two hundred and ten pounds to the said Rice B
Pence in hand paid by the said Lawrence Cook therewith receipted in hand
the said Pence doth hereby acknowledge - That he bargained and
confirmed and by these presents didl bargain all alien property
deliver unto the said Lawrence Cook his heirs &c a certain tract
of land lying in the county of Southampton, and containing by
estimation one hundred and fifty four acres to the same more or
less and bounded as followeth. Beginning at a sweet gum standing
on the road leading from flat swamp Bridge called Cooks to Burfins
bridge the same being a corner of Lawrence Cooks land thence along the
road to James Gees line there along the said Gees line to the head
of a swamp thence along the various courses of said swamp to a white
oak a corner in said Gees line thence along a line of marked trees to a
dyerwood a corner a corner between the said Oak and Pence thence
along James Gees line to a corner tree between the said Pence Cook
thence along a line of marked trees to the beginning -

To have and to hold the said land and premises with all
the appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Lawrence Cook
and to his heirs forever and the said Rice B Pence and his wife Frances
doth for themselves their heirs &c forever warrant and defend the
title of the said land unto him the said Lawrence Cook & to his heirs
and assigns forever against the claim of all and every person or
persons whatsoever lawfully claiming any part to parcel thereof.
