This Indenture made this twenty three day of November in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Daniel Wick of the parish of Nottoway and county of Southampton of the one part and Jesse Wick of the said parish and County of the other part Witnesses that the said Daniel Wick for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Daniel Wick doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Jesse Wick his heirs executors and administrators by these presents he the said Daniel Wick hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Jesse Wick and to his heirs or assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land (yet undivided between the heirs of Joseph Wick) It being my one well part of the land and plantation called Stratts which the said land fell to the aforesaid heirs by the death of Mary Wick deceased late Mary Hairsty wife of Joseph Wick living and being in the parish and county aforesaid containing by estimation

With the houses ways watercourses profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said plantation or tract or parcel of land belonging or in any way appertaining and the avers or sole reversions remainder or remainders unto profits thereof of every part and parcel thereof and all the right title interest or claim whatsoever of him the said Daniel Wick or his heirs to him the said Jesse Wick and to his heirs and assigns forever To have and to hold the said plantation parcel or tract of land and premises with the appurtenances to the same belonging to the said Jesse Wick &c the right and title of the said land and here the said Daniel Wick doth agree to warrant and forever defend against all persons or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof - In Witness whereof the said Daniel Wick hath hereunto set his hand and affix his seal the day and year first above written
