

his said brother in law Abshalom Daughtery as for and in consideration of the support and maintenance which the said Abshalom Daughtery by his bond bearing equal date with these presents hath bound himself his heirs and executors to furnish to the said William Williams for and during the natural life of him the said William Williams hath given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell enfeoff and confirm unto the said Abshalom Daughtery his heirs and assigns forever one horse one negro girl called Mary one cow and yearling two sheep and one sow and piggs all the household and kitchen furniture of him the said William Williams and one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said County of Southampton on the north side of Wottonway River it being a part of a tract of two hundred and twenty five acres granted and conveyed to Arthur Williams the grand father of the said William Williams by a certain Nathan formerly did bearing date the 27th day of January in the year 1723 which was afterwards devised by the said Arthur Williams to William Williams the father of the present grantor and finally devised by the said William Williams the father of the grantor in these presents bounded as follows beginning at a pine on the east side of a branch called Anthony's delight a line two of Anthony Lewis dec^d thence up the said branch by the meanders thereof to two black oaks near the corner of Richard Beale's former corner of said Beale now Jacob Beale and Arthur Williams thence north twenty five degrees west ninety four poles to a pine thence West North West one hundred and one poles or pole over the run of a branch thence down said branch by the meanders thereof to the first station containing two hundred acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the aforesaid Personal property and the said parcel and tract of land unto him the said Abshalom Daughtery his heirs and assigns forever Upon this condition that the said Abshalom Daughtery his heirs executors or adm^{rs} shall and will at all times during the life time of the said William Williams furnish the said William Williams with comfortable clothing lodging drink and diet or in other words that he furnish him a maintenance correspond- ing to the manner in which the said Abshalom Daughtery may live and support his family in and the said William Williams doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Abshalom Daughtery that he will forever warrant and defend
