This Indenture made this 26th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and four and fourteenth between George Curly executor of William Newsom deceased of Southampton county Virginia of the one part and John Thomas of Southampton county of the other part - Witnesseth that the said George Curly executor of William Newsom deceased for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand three hundred and fifty eight dollars and fifty cents to him in hand paid by the said John Thomas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth grant bargain and sell aliened enfeoff and confirm unto the said John Thomas his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation two hundred and forty seven acres be the same more or less situated lying and being in the county of Southampton on the South side of Tuckahatchee swamp and being as follows Viz Beginning at a small branch running head of a small branch thence to a maple standing at branch to the great branch thence the various courses of the Tuckahatchee swamp thence along the various
