 said Peter Wootton and honestly and obediently in all
 things shall behave himself towards his said master
 and honestly and obediently towards the rest of the family of
 the said George B. Cobb and the said George B. Cobb for
 his part for himself his executors and administrators doth
 hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseers
 of the poor and every of them their and every of their executors
 and administrators and their and every of their successors
 for the time being and to and with the said Peter Wootton
 that he the said George B. Cobb shall the said Peter Wootton
 in the Craft mystery and occupation of a farmer, which
 he the said George B. Cobb now useth after the best
 manner that the case or may teach instruct and inform
 a cause to be taught instructed and informed as much
 as thunske belongeth or in any wise appertaineth and
 that the said George B. Cobb shall also find and allow
 unto the said apprentice sufficient meat drink apparel
 Washing lodging and all other things need full or great
 for an apprentice during the term aforesaid and will
 moreover pay to the said Peter Wootton the sum of twelve
 dollars at the expiration of the aforesaid term
