This Indenture made this fourth day of January in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen between Daniel Pond and Polly his wife of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Henry Snow of the aforesaid county and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said Daniel Pond and Polly his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars unto them in hand paid by the said Henry Snow the receipt whereof the said Daniel Pond and Polly his wife doth hereby acknowledge the said Henry Snow they the said Daniel Pond and Polly his wife hath granted bargained, and sold aliened enfeoffed and conveyed unto the said Henry Snow one certain tract plantation of land containing by estimation one hundred and twenty five acres more or less lying and being in the county of Southampton state of Virginia and bounded by the lands of Robert Hooks William Spivey the lands belonging to the estate of Thomas Wood deceased and the lands of Henry Snow including all the lands purchased by the said Daniel Pond and Benjamin Snow as due for which was executed by the said Henry Snow and wife to the said Daniel Pond and wife in the county Court of Southampton reference being thereunto and will more fully appear with all houses
