

This Indenture made this second day of May in the year of
 our lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and fourteen
 between William Williford and Patsy his wife of the county of
 Southampton of the one part and Arthur Williamson of the said county
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Williford and
 Patsy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred and
 fifty four dollars to them in hand paid by the said Arthur Williamson
 the receipt whereof they the said William Williford and Patsy his wife
 do hereby acknowledge hath bargained sold aliened and confirmed
 and do by these presents bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said
 Arthur Williamson a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying
 and being in the county of Southampton on the west side of the three creeks
 containing by late survey one hundred and fifty six acres be the same
 more or less one hundred and fifteen acres of which I bought at the
 sale of Henry Thorpe deceased and forty one acres the balance of said
 156 acres above mentioned I got by the marriage of my wife late
 Patsy along which was given her by Henry Thorpe etc and lastly
 Lucy Long during her life, bounded as follows to wit Beginning at the
 road in Rehoboth branch thence up and along the various corners of said
 branch to Arthur Williamsons land thence along said Williamsons
 line to a large pine a corner of said Williamsons line and a line
 tree in Allen Jones's line thence along said Jones's line to a spanish
 oak a corner of the said life estate of Lucy Longs land thence North
 twenty six degrees West eighty eight feet to a pine thence South thirty
 nine degrees West to Hickory in Allen Jones's line thence along said
 Jones's line untill it strikes Benjamin Blythe's line thence along the
 said Blythe's line to the road leading from Beaufield to Jerusalem
 thence down the various corners of said road to the beginning, and also
 all houses lands waters watercourses profits commodities advantages
 hindrances and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel
 of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and be the reversion
 and reversion remainder and remainders unto and services of all and
 singular the said premises and every part and parcel thereof and
 also all the estate right title interest claim property and demand
 whatsoever of them the said William Williford and Patsy his wife
 for and to the same to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of
 land and premises with its appurtenances unto the said Arthur
 Williamson his heirs and assigns against them the said William
 Williford and Patsy his wife and their heirs and against all other persons
 or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by
