Beginning at a pine a corner line to a gum a corner tree standing in the Cypress swamp in Darden Williams line thence up the run or centre of said swamp to a corner maple standing near and below the road leading from Drownes Ferry thence along a line of marked trees to a small pine standing near the north side of the long pond a corner line in the lands of the late Elijah Hensell deceased thence

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
