 at a chest pine in a small branch and in said Bly's line
 thence nearly North along said Bly's line to a post in the
 big branch and then to the main and thence down the
 various courses of said run to the mouth of the branch begin-
 ning and thence up the run of said small branch to the pine
 sixty six pole the beginning and also all trees woods underwoods
 common of pastures perfect commodities advantages
 emolument and hereditaments whatsoever to the said tract or
 parcel of land above mentioned belonging or in any wise apper-
 taining or in or upon the same growing happening or
 remaining and also the reversion and reversions cum and in said
 tract thereof to the only proper use and behoof the said Bly
 his heirs to be have and to hold all and singular the said
 premises above mentioned and the said Putter and wife for
 their against themselves and their heirs and every part
 wholy of person and persons do and shall warrant and
 forever defend by their persons in In Witness whereof the
 said Thomas Putter and wife Jane have hereunto set their
 signs seals and acknowledged the day and year above written
