

This Indenture made the 20th day of October in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two between John M. Johnson of the County of Warren and State of North Carolina of the one part and Susan Johnson of the County and State aforesaid of the other part - Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars to him the said John M. Johnson in hand paid by the said Susan Johnson the receipt whereof to the said John M. Johnson he hereby acknowledges he hath granted bargained and sold released and confirmed and do by these presents grant bargain and sell release and confirm unto the said Susan Johnson his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing two hundred acres more or less it being the same tract of land sold to the said John M. Johnson by the said Susan Johnson and Betsy his wife which said two hundred acres of land was attested to the aforesaid Betsy at the division of the estate of Samuel Edmunds deceased and bounded by the lands of John Day and others To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with all and every of its appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Susan Johnson his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of her the said Susan Johnson he heirs and assigns forever and the said John M. Johnson the aforesaid tract of land and premises with all and every of its appurtenances not only against himself and his heirs but against all and every other person and persons in trespass with warrant and force defend by these presents In Witness whereof I the said John M.
