In a white oak standing in said river there is with 100 West 42 poles
 to the first station also a part of one other tract which Jacob C.
 Vick bequeathed in his last will and testament unto the said Richard
 E Williams and wife bearing date the 28th day of July in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten containing by estimate
 two ninety seven acres and one third in the same more or less to
 bounded as follows to wit beginning at a white oak standing in
 flaggy river running thence South 37° West 60 poles to a willow
 oak a corner in Jacob Vick's line standing in the horse pen
 branch, then along said branch a dividing line of Samuel Hobbs
 second and said Williams the various curves thereof to a new corner
^{the reading in the same branch being a corner}
 on Elizabeth Vick's lower line thence along her lower line which
 is a straight line to flaggy river swamp and from thence down the
 various curves of the said flaggy river to the first station, with all
 the houses and houses and offices buildings in the same waters and rales
 and various low grounds pastures profits commodities hereditaments
 and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any
 wise appertaining and the reversion and reverions remainder and
 unclaimed rents and profits thereof and all the estate right title
 interest claim and demands of the said Richard E Williams and
 Patsy his wife of in and to the same and every part and parcel
 thereof to have and to hold the said plantation meadowes tracts
 and parcels of two hundred and even and half acres of land and
 premises with all and every the appurtenances aforesaid unto the said
 Noel Waddell and to his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper
 use and behoef of him the said Noel Waddell and his heirs and
 assigns forever unto the said Richard E Williams and Patsy his
 wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators the said
 plantation meadowes tracts and parcels of land of two hundred
 even seven and a half acres of land and premises with all and
 every of the appurtenances aforesaid unto the said Noel Waddell
 and to his heirs and assigns against them the said Richard E Williams
 and Patsy his wife their heirs executors administrators and assigns
 and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever do
 whenever claiming or demanding the same or any part or
 parcel thereof shall and will warrant and forever defend by
 these presents in writing whereof the said Richard E Williams of Patsy
 his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day &
 year first above written —
