Given & Suffice
This Indenture made the 22nd day of June 18th by and between Jacob Davidson of Southampton county Virginia of the one part and Pharaoh Grifford of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Pharaoh Grifford did on the fifth day of July in the year four last one thousand eight hundred and eight cents to the said Jacob Davidson a deed for one certain tract or parcel of land being in the aforesaid county of Southampton on the west side of Black water river commonly called the Old quarry with all the appurtenances thereto as mentioned in the said deed also one negro man named Abraham (which said negro is since died) one small mare three feather beds one duck ten heads of Hogs & Iron pots & frying pan & chests and all the other household & kitchen furniture and plantation utensils and all the other property then owned and possessed by the said Pharaoh Grifford including the crop from four acres of land to be made on and gathered from the said land within that year and whereas the said land and other above mentioned property was conveyed as aforesaid to the said Jacob Davidson in trust to secure a debt then due and owing from him to the said Pharaoh Grifford to John Lee both of whom are parties to the said deed in trust which debt amounted to two hundred and forty three dollars 94 cents as mentioned in the said deed in trust and whereas the said debt with all the interest thereon accruing was on the fifth day of this present month fully paid and discharged by Isaac O. Holland which debt with its interest amounted at that time to the hundred and thirty dollars and fifty three cents. Now all men by these presents that he the said Jacob Davidson for and in consideration of the payment of the debt aforesaid which was the sole object and design of the execution of the deed aforesaid for himself (his heirs executors and
