 Abbigdon Harny stands indebted by bond to the said James Scott in
 the sum of six hundred and five dollars and twenty three cents and
 whereas for the further convenience of the premises it is agreed by
 the parties unto that all consequences in trust shall be made to the
 said Zebedee Washington for the benefit of the said James Scott
 in case the said bond shall not be punctually paid with lawful
 interest thereon on or before the first day of March next —
 Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Abbigdon Harny
 for and in consideration of the premises and for the further sum of one
