This Indenture made this 21<sup>st</sup> day of July in the year of Christ  
1814 between John Day of the one part and Etheldred Edmunds of  
the other part both of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia  
Witnesseth that the said John Day for and in consideration of the  
sum of two hundred and fifty five dollars to him in hand paid by  
the said Etheldred Edmunds, his heirs and assigns forever have granted  
bargained sold aliened released to him in hand paid by  
the said Etheldred Edmunds, his heirs and assigns forever have granted  
and deliverd unto him the said Etheldred Edmunds and to his heirs &  
assigns forever, One certain piece of land containing  
by a late survey forty four and an half acres to the same more  
or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a small black gum  
standing in a small branch a corner of John Day running thence  
North 60° East 83 pole thence at 38° E 60 pole thence at 15°
