 sum of two hundred and sixty five dollars to him in hand paid by
 the said Ethelred Edmunds his heirs and assigns forever have granted
 bargained sold aliened conveyed confirmed and delivered and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell alien convey release set over confirm
 and deliver unto him the said Ethelred Edmunds and to his heirs &
 assigns forever One certain piece parcel and tract of land contain-
 ing by a late survey forty four and one half acres situate more
 or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a small black gum
 standing in a small branch a corner of John Day running thence
 North 60° East 83 poles thence N 88° E 60 poles thence N 75°
