all kinds to have and to hold the said property hereinafter  
mentioned to him the said Thomas Fells his heirs and assigns  
to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Thomas Fells  
his heirs &c and the said Nathaniel Fells do warrant the title  
said property to the said Thomas Fells and his heirs forever  
against any other person or persons whatsoever - Witness my  
hand and seal this twentieth day of October 1813 -
