This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of
May in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight
hundred and fourteen between Benjamin Jelks of the county
of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part
and Thomas Jelks of the same County and State of the other
part Witnesses that the said Benjamin Jelks for and
in consideration of the sum of four shillings to him in hand
paid by the said Thomas Jelks the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged the said Benjamin Jelks hath granted
bargained sold aliened released and confirmed unto the said Thomas
Jelks to him and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton on the
South side of Watoway River containing thirty acres be the
same more or less beginning as follows Viz at a small
oak a new corner in Robert and Procella Jelks line
along the said Piscataway Jelks line to a bunch of small
oaks bushes a corner in Moses Fosters line thence along
the said Fosters line to a ^{small} ^{standing} ^{oak} ^{tree} ^{line} ^{thence}
the said Fosters line to a ^{small} ^{standing} ^{oak} ^{tree} ^{line} ^{thence}
line thence along a line of marked trees to a small
said line to a white oak begun at
