This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of February in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twelve Between Richard E Williams and Patey his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one Part and Samuel Wallcut of the same County and State aforesaid of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Richard E Williams and Patey his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and twenty dollars, the receipt of which said sum the said Richard E Williams and Patey his wife doth hereby acknowledge and themselves therewith fully satisfied Contented and paid hath bargained, sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby bargain sell alien enfeoff and forever confirm unto the said Samuel Wallcut his heirs and assigns one certain piece or parcel of good land lying and being situate in the parish of Stotterway and County aforesaid on the east side of Flaggys Run Swamp and is bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at an Ash standing in the spring branch a corner of Thomas Johnson and said Wallcut, thence running north thirty two degrees West two hundred and forty poles to a willow oak standing in the flag branch a corner of Joseph Bracey and Jacob (free negro) thence down the various courses of the said branch to Flaggys Run Swamp thence down the various of the run of said swamp to a post oak a corner standing in David Doyalls line thence up the various
