 therefore command you that you or personally go to the said Patsy
 privately and apart from the same and examine her
 husband whether she doth the same freely and voluntarily
 without his persuasions or threats and whether she be willing
 that the same shall be recorded in our County Court of Southampton
 aforesaid and when you have received her acknowledgment and
 examined her as aforesaid that you distinctly and openly certify
 as thereof in our said County Court under your seal sending then
 the said Indenture and this writ. Witness Samuel Wells
 Clerk of our said Court at his office the 11th day of February
 1814 and 35th year of the Commonwealth. *Sam^l Wells*
 Specially to the within Commission to us directed we have
 examined Mrs Patsy Williams wife of the within named Richard
 E Williams separately and apart from her said husband touch-
 ing the premises to the within married title to said land and
 she acknowledges that she signed the same freely and voluntarily
 without the threats or persuasions of her said husband and
 that she is willing the same shall be recorded in Southampton
 County Court given under our hands and seals this 19th day
 of May one thousand eight hundred and fourteenth

 15th day of August 1814 A Commission for the proving
 examination of Mrs Patsy Williams and a Certificate of its
 execution returned and ordered to be recorded in *Sam^l Wells*

This Indenture made this 9th day of January in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine between Benjamin
 Turner Senr of Southampton County and state of Virginia of the
 one part and Samuel Turner of said County and state aforesaid
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Turner &c
