This Indenture was made and entered into this 9th day of July in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteenth between Arthur A. Carr and Jane his wife of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Clements Rochelle of the aforesaid County and state of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Arthur A. Carr and Jane his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and eighty dollars in hand paid and truly paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. They the said Arthur A. Carr and Jane his wife hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Clements Rochelle his heirs and assigns one messuage tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton on the south side of the Cypress swamp containing by estimation twenty acres less the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) on the south by the lands of Stephen A. Carr on the West and North by the lands of Clements Rochelle and on the East by the lands of William C. Carr.
