This Indenture made this day of in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and fourteenth between Benjamin Cobb of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the one part and James Brewster of the other part Witnesseth that him the said Benjamin Cobb for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars and twenty five Cents to him in hand paid at and before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he does hereby acknowledge and himself to be therewith fully satisfied contented and paid him the said Benjamin Cobb have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said James Brewster his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or piece of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton on the south side of Appoys swamp containing by estimation seventy five acres more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a pine corner tree in Abraham Mitchells line thence a rope the ridge to the center of the swamp to a black gum a corner tree for Thacker Cobb thence down the center of the swamp to a black gum a corner tree for Thacker Cobb thence across the ridge of cleared land to a pine corner tree for Henry Vaughan to the center of the Appoys swamp thence down the center of the swamp and round to the first station containing by estimation seventy five acres be the same more or less to have and to hold the land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto in any manner issuing or proceeding to him the said James Brewster his heirs and assigns forever and him the said
