This Indenture made the 9th day of July in the year
 of our lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen between
 Clemente Rochelle and Nancy his wife of the County of
 Southampton and state of Virginia of one part and Sally
 Maget of the County of Hertford and state of North Carolina
 of the other part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration
 of the sum of three thousand and fifty dollars to her the said
 Sally Maget in hand well and truly paid the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged they the said Clemente Rochelle and
 Nancy his wife hath granted bargained and sold unto the said
 present doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Sally
 Maget her heirs and assigns two meadowes tract or parcels
 of land lying and being in the County of Southampton contain-
 ing by estimation seventy and one half acres which the said
 Clemente Rochelle purchased of John Everett and which descended
 to the said John Everett by the death of Nicholas Everett and
 commencing on the south at a pine stump in the said County
 and bounded otherwise by the lands of said Sally Maget
 and Clemente Rochelle also twenty acres and one fourth a acre
 lying on the north sides of the aforesaid thirty eight and one
 fourth acres and bounded on the north as follows (to wit)
 beginning at a pine stump in William Bryants line thence
 along a straight line of marked trees an east corner to a
 branch making in all seventy five and one half acres
 to have and to hold the said meadowes and parcels of land
 together with all and singular every appurtenance thereunto
