of the Peace in pursuance of an act of assembly in such cases
made and provided and is admitted to record James Rockelle &c.

This Indenture made and entered into this first day
of July in the year of our Lord 1800 and fourth by and between
Charles Edmunds executor of the last will and testament of M^{rs} Mary
deceased late of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
of the first part and John Blith of the same County and State of
the other part Witnesseth that the said Charles Edmunds
executor of the last will and testament of the said M^{rs} Mary de-
ceased in pursuance of the authority vested in him by the last will and
testament and for good consideration of the sum of four thousand nine
hundred and seven dollars current money of the United States to him
in hand paid by the said John Blith at and before the executing
and delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof is hereby
