This instrument made and intended on the sixth day of July in the
year one thousand eight hundred and fourteen between Ethelred Edmunds executor
of the last will and testament of Miles Cary deceased late of the county
of Southampton and state of Virginia of the first part and the testatrix
of the same county and state and Lewis Taylor of the County of Granville
in the state of North Carolina who intermarried with Piggy Cary daughter
of the said Miles Cary deceased of the other part witnesseth that the
said Ethelred Edmunds executor of the last will and testament of the said
Miles Cary deceased in presence of the authority testis in him by
the said will and testament and for and in consideration of the
sum of seventeen hundred and twelve dollars and twenty five cents current
money of the United States so him in hand paid by the said John Stith
and Lewis Taylor at and before the executing and delivery of these presents
be full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and from every part of
which the said John Stith and Lewis Taylor and all the legal representa-
tives are forever released exonerated and discharged both granted bar-
gained sold aliened transferred unfeoffed and confirmed and doth hereby
grant bargain sell alien transfer unfeoff and confirm unto the said
John Stith and Lewis Taylor their heirs and assigns one certain tract
of land situate lying and being in the said County of Southampton
containing five hundred and twenty seven acres known by the name
of buck horn and bounded as follows to wit beginning at the mill
Run of Barnes mill near the mill house running thence South
88 E 186 pole to a hickory a corner of Nathaniel Foster others
855 E 110 pole to a pine a corner of said Foster and Henry Blow
thence North 17 E 232 pole to the Indian fishing place on a tortuous
river to a black gum thence N 58 W 166 pole to the end of the Indian
fishing place thence along the river S 75 W 979 80 pole to buck horn
whereby the water that swamp the various courses thereof to the
beginning to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
containing five hundred and twenty seven acres and bounded as aforesaid
and all and singular the appurtegances thereto in any manner
belonging to them the said John Stith and Lewis Taylor their heirs
and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of them the said
John Stith and Lewis Taylor their heirs and assigns forever and the
said Ethelred Edmunds executor of the last will and testament of the
said Miles Cary deceased hereby covenants with the said John Stith
and Lewis Taylor and their heirs that he will forever narrast and
affre the said tract or parcel of land known by the name of
Buck horn containing five hundred and twenty seven acres and
