This Indenture made this 22nd day of November in the
Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen
between Martha Tynes of the County of Southampton of the
one part and William Stringfield of the aforesaid County of
the other part - Witnesseth that the said Martha Tynes
for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds current
money of Virginia to her in hand paid the said William Stringfield
at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipts
whereof the said Martha Tynes doth hereby acknowledge
and herself therewith to be satisfied and paid and thereof doth
clearly acquit and discharge the said William Stringfield his
heirs executors and assigns forever by these presents hath given
granted bargained and sold enfeoffed and confirmed and by these
presents doth give grant bargain sell enfeoff and confirm
unto the said William Stringfield his heirs and assigns forever
one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation
fifty seven Acres be the same more or less lying and being
in the County of Southampton and bounded as followeth to wit
beginning at a pine a corner tree of said William Stringfield
and Martha Tynes on the Bank of black water river from
thence a line of marked trees Southeast to a Cypress adjoining
Brazant Crumpler land in Black water from thence up said
River north east to the first station - With all houses
orchards gardens fences woods underwoods waters and watercourses
and with all profits Commodities advantages emoluments and
appurtenances whatsoever part and parcel thereof To have
and to hold the said tract or parcels of land with all and
singular the appurtenances unto the said William Stringfield
his heirs and assigns to the only use and behoof of them the said
