This Indenture made this thirteenth day of April in the
Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourty between
Richard Henry Edwards and William and Williams Edwards
and Frances his wife all of the county of Surrey of the first
part and Thomas Tunson of the county of Southampton
of the second part witnesseth that the said Richard H.
Edwards and William Edwards and Frances his wife for
and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars &
them in hand paid and before the sealing and delivery of this
present by the said Thomas Tunson the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged and the said Thomas Tunson former
acquitted and discharged of the same have granted bargained
and alured enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do grant
bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Thomas
Tunson his heirs and assigns forever two hundred and five
of one hundred and six parts of a tract of land lying and
being in the said county of Southampton on the South
side of Nottonway river containing sixteen hundred and two
acres or there abouts being the same tract of land devised
to Thomas Edwards deceased late of the said County of Surrey
his last will and testament of a certain William Edwards
late of the same County and which descended to the said Richd
H Edwards and William Edwards and the surviving brother
and sister of a certain Charlotte B Edwards who was born
after the date of the said last will and testament of the
aforesaid William Edwards the father of the said Charlotte
Edwards To have and to hold the said hundred and
fifths of one hundred and six parts of the aforesaid tract of land
to the said Thomas Tunson his heirs and assigns forever by
her with all and singular the appurtenances thereto
belonging or in anywise appertaining and the said Richd
H Edwards and William Edwards and Frances his wife
do for themselves their heirs Executors and Administrators
Covenant and agree to and with the said Thomas Tunson his
heirs and assigns that they will forever warrant & defend
the right and title in and to the aforesaid hundred and five
