This Indenture made this eighteenth day of October in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between
 Ligan Johnson and Betsey his wife of the County of Warren
 State of North Carolina of the one part and John M. Johnson
 of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that
 for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars paid
 them the said Ligan Johnson and Betsey in hand paid by the
 said John M. Johnson the receipt whereof they the said Ligan
 and Betsey do hereby acknowledge they have given granted bargained
 and sold released and confirmed and by their presents doth give
 grant bargain and sell release and confirm unto the said
 John M. Johnson his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or
 parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Hampton
 State of Virginia containing two thousand acres more or less
 it being the same tract of land which the said Betsey bore
 at the division of the estate of Samuel Edmondes dec'd including
 the houses of the said Samuel Edmondes dec'd and bounded by the
 lands of John Day and others - To have and to hold the afore-
 said tract of land and premises with all and every of its appur-
 tenances unto the said John M. Johnson his heirs and assigns
 forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John
 M. Johnson his heirs and assigns forever and the said Ligan
 Johnson and Betsey his wife the aforesaid tract of land and
 premises with all and every of its appurtenances not only
 against themselves and their heirs but against all and every
 other Person and Persons whatsoever with warrant and good
 defense by their presents -
