 Johnson of the county of Warren and state of North Carolina two
 hundred acres of land more or less lying in the county of Hampton
 it being the same tract of land which the said Betsey drew at the
 death of Samuel Edmunds estate and where as the said Betsey
 cannot conveniently travel to our County court of Southampton to
 make acknowledgment of the said conveyance Therefore we do give
 unto you or any two or more of your power to receive the acknow-
 ledgment which the said Betsey shall be willing to make before
 you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture
 which is hereto annexed and we do therefore command you that
 you do prudently go to the said Betsey and receive the acknow-
 ledgment of the same and examine her privately and apart
