Know all men by these presents that I Matthew Daughtery Senior of the county of Sale of Wight guardian to Elizabeth Daughtery and orphan of Theophilus Daughtery do for and in Consideration of the sums and agreements hereafter mentioned do bargain sell &c. have a certain plantation or tract of land lying in the county of Southampton and situated immediately on Black water River and adjoining South quay Bridge unto Anthony Birdsong his heirs and assigns together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto to commence the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and fifteen and continues for the term of six years and the said Anthony Birdsong doth hereby bind himself his heirs and assigns in the sum of sixty dollars to put all the cleared lands belonging to the said plantation under a good fence and return it in the like Condition at the expiration of the lease.

In Witness whereof the parties have interchangeably set their hands and seals this 12th day of January 1815.
