To all whom these presents shall come I do hereby certify that
 I Jacob Porter of the county of Southampton for and in consid-
 eration of the natural love and affection that I have for my
 son William Porter of the county aforesaid and also for one
 dollar to me in hand paid by the said William Porter do give
 and grant unto my said son William Porter a part of the tract
 of land whereon I now live containing sixty five acres more or less
 and bounded as follows beginning at a white oak a line between
 Peter Edwards and Jacob Porter thence down a large path
 to a pine a corner tree straight course down to a pine thence down
 the Run branch to the run of Moses swamp thence up the
 run of said swamp to a maple to Peter Edwards line thence
 along the said line to the beginning. I have and to hold the
 said parcel of land to the said William Porter and behoof of him the
 said William Porter and to his heirs forever and I the said
 Jacob Porter for myself and my heirs do by these presents
