the said Henry Briggs administrator as aforesaid doth consent to and  
in virtue of the power in him vested by the last will and testa-  
ment of the said Samuel Calvert deceased for and in consideration  
of the sum of Twenty dollars in hand paid at and before the  
making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said  
Henry Briggs doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every  
part thereof doth hereby exonerate and discharge the said James  
Thygart his executors and administrators the said Henry  
Briggs administrator as aforesaid hath granted bargained sold  
aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant  
bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said James  
Thygart his heirs and assigns forever a certain part or parcel
