

**This Indenture**

made this ninth day of February in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between  
Elizabeth Vick of the county of Southampton of the one part  
and Collin Fletcher of the other parts Witnesseth that the said  
Elizabeth Vick for and in consideration of the sum of forty dollars to  
her in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
hath given granted bargained, sold and delivered and doth hereby  
quit grant set over and release to and in favour of the said  
Collin Fletcher all her right title Interest and claim of  
every kind whatsoever in and to her dower right and Interest  
in a certain parcel of ground situated on the east side of the  
Town of Jerusalem adjoining the said town containing about  
one acre be the same more or less with all houses always water  
and water courses the same being one third part of a piece of  
ground heretofore sold by George Surly Executor of Josiah Vick  
and purchased by William Hart and lately divided so as to  
belong to her the said Elizabeth Vick one third part thereof is  
right of dower with all and singular the appurtenances thereto  
belonging — To have and to hold to him the said Collin  
Fletcher and his heirs forever to possess and enjoy the same in as  
full and ample manner as she herself might or could do release  
ing hereby to him the said Collin Fletcher every kind of claim  
accruing to her in the premises in consequence of her intmarriage  
with the said Josiah Vick deceased her late husband —
