Witnesseth that the said Samuel Hitchcock being willing to secure a debt due to the said John Shields of forty one pounds eleven shillings and 6^d Virginia money and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Bartlett Pond, the receipt is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and confirmed and do by these presents grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Bartlett Pond as trustee aforesaid certain tract and parcel of land in the County of Southampton and on the north side of round hill swamp containing by estimation twenty acres be the same more or less which said tract of land was purchased by the said Hitchcock of the said John Shields the
