This Indenture made this 20th day of May in the year
 Christ one thousand eight hundred and fourteen between Benjamin
 Blunt and Richard Blunt executors of the last will and testament
 of Benjamin Blunt dec'd of the one part and William Blunt
 administrator of Samuel Wells dec'd of the other part Witnesseth
 that whereas Samuel Wells became justly indebted to Mr. Ruffin
 administrator of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of
 William Edwards dec'd by writing obligatory under seal in the
 sum of four hundred and ninety pounds seven shillings payable
 or before the twentieth day of December 1769 with Interest
 of punctually paid when due and the said Samuel Wells Executor
 for the further securing the said debt did execute to Benjamin
 Blunt dec'd a deed in Trust for the benefit of the said Mr. Ruffin
 executor William Edwards dec'd therein conveyed a certain tract
 or parcel of land and plantation situated lying and being in the
 County of Southampton aforesaid called and known by the name
 of his the said Samuel Wells upper quarter containing by esti-
 -mation four hundred and seventy five acres be the same more
 or less bounded by the lands of Benjamin Drew, William Vaghabat
 Miller Deloach and the said Samuel Wells other lands also the
 following named to wit: Mansfield London John Hannah
 Barak and then two Duties Amy and Harrison Tom Daily
 and London which said deed in Trust hath been duly recorded
 in the county Court of Southampton reference being had thereto
 the same well fully appear and the said Benjamin Blunt
 departed this life sometime in the year 1805 having first read
 and executed his last will and testament therein appointed
 certain Benjamin Blunt Jun^r and Richard Blunt executors of his
 who took upon themselves the burthen of the execution thereof
 due and solemn form of law and the said Samuel Wells
