 a certain Samuel Kelle Junr. became possessed of the aforesaid land or
 part thereof who have since conveyed the same to a certain Thomas
 Gray of this county by deed which is also recorded in the county Court
 aforesaid reference being had thereto the conveyance last aforesaid
 will fully appear and whereas at the the said William Reiffin an
 administrator of William Edwards deceased as aforesaid hath
 been duly satisfied and paid and released having been made and
 executed by the said Benjamin Blunt Senr. to the said Samuel Kelle
 Senr. since his death; and the said Benjamin Blunt and Richard
 Blunt executors of Benjamin Blunt Senr. and for themselves their
 heirs executors doth hereby release relinquish and quit claim to
 all or any title which might have been or now has to the
 said William Blount administrator of Samuel Kelle Senr. deceased
 to said Samuel Kelle Junr. and Thomas Gray their heirs executors
 and assigns of in or any title interest claim or demand which
 they have as executors of Benjamin Blunt Senr. who was trustee
 as aforesaid and the said Benjamin Blunt and Rich^d Blunt
 executors as aforesaid for themselves their heirs executors and assigns
 doth hereby renounce the trust which they might have as executors
 as aforesaid in the said deed mentioned from Kelle to Blunt for the
 benefit of Reiffin administrator of Edwards - In witness
 whereof the said Ben^g Blunt of Rich^d Blunt ex^{rs} of Ben^g Blunt Senr.
 deceased hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this 25th
 and year first above written
