and being in the county of Southampton aforesaid and bounded  
as follows (to wit) beginning and bounded by the known bound-  
ries and standing lines of the tract of land that the said  
William Whitehead did purchase by and of John Kinross  
for and in behalf of his son Richard Whitehead and is bound  
one side by the water course called the little swamp and by the  
said Richard brought into hatchet with the other land of  
the said deceased and all the right title and claim of him  
the said Joseph Bowwell Whitehead to the aforesaid Joseph D  
Beale to have and to hold the said tract of land and premises  
unto him the said Joseph D Beale and to his heirs and assigns  
forever and the said Joseph Bowwell Whitehead for himself his  
heirs and assigns doth sell and defend the title of the aforesaid  
tract of land unto Joseph D Beale and to his heirs and assigns  
against himself the said Joseph Bowwell Whitehead and against  
all and every other person or persons whatsoever claiming or  
demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof of the same  
land shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
