This Indenture made this 21st 21st day of January in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen between Williamson Edwards and Lucy his wife of the County of Southampton and state of North Carolina of the one Part & Lewis Norrell of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the other Part Witnesseth that the said Williamson Edwards and Lucy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twelve dollars and fifty cents to them the said Williamson Edwards and Lucy in hand paid by the said Lewis Norrell the receipt whereof is by them acknowledged and themselves satisfied they the said Williamson Edwards and Lucy his wife have given granted bargained sold and delivered and do by these presents give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Lewis Norrell and his heirs forever one certain lot or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton situated on the south side of Pottery River containing fourteen and one half acres, being the lot N. 7 drawn by the said Williamson Edwards in a division of his deceased fathers lands in making a distribution thereof by certain Commissioners appointed to represent the same, under a decree for dividing the said Edwards lands amongst his heirs and bound as follows Beginning at a pine stub a new corner made in lot N. 8 which is James Bowdens lot running thence South to West 50 poles to another pine stub a corner of lots N. 5, 6 and 8 being a corner of James Bowdens Nathaniel Edwards Peterson Edwards and Williamson Edwards, thence North 43° West 64 poles to another lightwood stub a new corner made in Thomas Browners line, thence North 86. E 70 poles to given pine a corner of Lewis Norrells standing at his gate then South 44. E 30 poles to the first station South all and singular
