This Indenture was made by the oaths of Richard
Murfee Elisha Joyner and James Powell testifies there is per-
suance of an act of assembly in such cases to be observed
and admitted to be received And at a court held for the said County
of Southampton the 17th day of April 1815 This Indenture as aforesaid
was entered upon the proceedings of the day - Teste M. Bell.

This Indenture made this 20th day of October in the year
of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and fourteen between
Leon Williams of the county of Southampton and Parish of Wotton
of the one part and Burnell Burn of the same County & Parish
of the other part - Witnesseth that the said Leon Williams for and
in consideration of the sum of one thousand and seventy eight dollars
more fifty cents good and lawful money of Virginia to him the said
Leon Williams in hand paid by the said Burnell Burn the
receipt whereof the said Leon Williams doth acknowledge himself
fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargain'd and
aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
bargain and sell unto the said Burnell Burn to him and to his
heirs forever One certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate
lying and being in the county of ^{and parish of} Southampton containing by estimation
a little more or less as follows to wit beginning at a post
standing between the Williams and Leon Williams (bearing thence N 20° 15' E 100 feet
and standing in the head of a small branch thence South 61
West 15 feet down said branch thence the various courses of the same
